

Devon Hybrid Registry

Registry Instructions



Introduction

The Devon Hybrid Registry has been designed to record the heritage and pedigree of Red Devon influenced cattle. Animals are eligible for registry in the Devon Hybrid Registry if it at least 50% registered Red Devon.

Eligibility for Registration in the Devon Hybrid Registry

1. One parent must be registered purebred with Red Devon USA
2. The other breed component must be of *Bos Taurus* beef breed
3. Applicant must be a member in good standing of Red Devon USA

Identification

1. Animals recorded in the Devon Hybrid Registry will be assigned a registration number beginning with DHR
2. All animals must be tattooed or branded as a permanent form of identification. Herd prefix should be used in the right ear and individual animal number in the left ear followed by an "X"

How to Register your Devon Hybrid Animals

Foundation Animal Entry

Foundation animals are the non-registered Devon animals that you wish to register Devon Hybrid calves from. These can be either the sire or the dam. Foundation animals can be registered with another recognized breed association or be commercial.

- Registered Foundation Animals
 - o If your foundation sire or dam is registered with another association, a copy of that animal's registration certificate must accompany the DHR application for their first DHR calf.
- Commercial & Unregistered Foundation Animals
 - o Complete the PDF or Excel entry form for Foundation Animals. Required information includes:
 - Animal Name, Date of Birth (Season and Year if exact date unknown) & Sex, Horn/Polled status, Permanent ID, Type & Location, Body Color, Sire (if known), Dam (if known)
 - Breed Composition (% or fraction)
 - Example 50% black angus, 50% unknown or crossbred
- Foundation Animals can be submitted before or at the same time as a DHR registration application
- The more information known about the Foundation animal the more complete the DHR animal's registration certificate will be.

DHR Calf Registration

- After foundation animal application completed (or foundation animal already recorded) complete the DHR Registration Application found on the website under the Registry tab. E-mail or Mail forms to Red Devon USA
